

2021-03-09 dbPoweramp debug information:

This example shows a difference in behaviour of the Music Converter depending on how I specify the output folder. It also shows that the network does not play any role in the problem, as I am converting from-to exactly the same folder on the local C: drive.

I am converting the file 'c:\temp\25 Bastien und Bastienne - 25. Sieh an! Du bist noch hierç - W. A. Mozart.flac' to mp3. I do so by right-clicking on the file name in Windows Explorer and selecting 'Convert to'.

1) In the first run I am using 'Output To' = 'C:\Temp\Source Filename' (selected as 'Single Folder'):



The result is this:

I.e. the character 'ç' was changed to '½'. The debug log is attached as file 'DBGF323.txt'.

2) Before running the conversion again I delete the mp3 file created in the first run. In the second run I am Using 'Output To' = 'Existing Source Folder(s)':
